Dante Jones is a writer, producer, and artist originally from Denver and now residing in LA. He is one half of the WBR signed duo – THEY. One of their first releases was a feature with ZHU – “Working For It” co-written with Skrillex, which has been streamed over 150 million times. Around the same time THEY. released their debut EP, Nü Religion, and a few months later found themselves playing their first ever live show—in front of a 1500-strong audience opening for Bryson Tiller on his Trapsoul tour. Today, the duo’s most recent EP – Fireside has features with Wiz Khalifa, Jessie Reyez, Jeremih, Vic Mensa, Ty Dolla \$ign, and Gallant.

As a producer and writer, Dante works across genres. He’s influenced by R&B acts like Prince, Bobby Brown, and New Edition. He’s also very much a child of the 90s alternative and hip-hop scenes listening to Fall Out Boy, No Doubt, and Rage Against The Machine alongside The Diplomats and Juvenile. Dante won a grammy for his work with Kelly Clarkson, he co-wrote and co-produced “Mr. Know It All” in addition he has cuts with Chris Brown, CeeLo, Jessie Reyez, Tori Kelly, Gallant, Emotional Oranges, Sinead Harnett, Khalid, Sabrina ...
